 - As the date/time of the social slipped the minds of several residents who signed up to attend, the Committee discussed reminder options for future events
- 3. Future Events
 - Wine and Food Pairing: Saturday July 16, 7:00pm; rain date Sunday July 17
 - Over 40 residents have signed up
 - Janine purchased the wines that were chosen in consultation with Bernd
 - Rick, Janine, and Suzanne have the food menu well in hand and will use the lounge amenities to store, prepare, and plate the offerings
 - Rick will prepare a sheet detailing the food and wine pairings
 - Janine will prepare nametags for all attendees in advance, given the number of new residents who signed up to attend and the benefit of clear, unrushed writing

- Suzanne will provide serving trays, doilies, cork mats, and tablecloths with weights
- Alan and Gordon will serve the wine out on the patio
- Suzanne will prepare and continue to refill two glass jugs of water, as a non-alcoholic alternative and for palate cleansing
- Patio Potluck: Saturday August 13, 6:00pm; rain date Sunday August 14
 - Rick has prepared the poster and sign-up sheet which will be posted after the Wine and Food Pairing; wording was added to include purchased contributions from attendees who choose not to cook

 - BYO plates/bowls, cutlery, and napkins; paper plates will be provided for the dessert course
 - The Committee will offer a red and a white wine to accompany the meal, as well as water
 - Rick and Janine will source the wine
- Pizza in Piazza: Saturday September 10, 5:00pm; rain date Sunday September 11
 - Nancy and Rosemary will order a selection of pizza from Wooden Heads based on last year's successful choices
 - Suzanne will prepare crudité platters
 - Alan will source lemon biscotti
 - Rick will prepare a poster and sign-up sheet to post after the Patio Potluck
